<b>1. Seychelles:</b> Beaches and leisure activities on the island.	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Some of most beautiful beaches in world.</li> <li>• The beaches attract tourists because of their soft white sand</li> <li>• The year-round warm weather.</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• The resort offers a wide variety of activities like swimming, snorkeling, fishing, water skiing, kayaking and boat trips.</li> <li>• There are 65 beaches along the island of Mahé.</li> <li>• Tourists can hire boats for island hopping.</li> </ul>	
<b>2. Swaziland:</b> Hlane Royal National Park	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Country's largest protected area.</li> <li>• Largest game herds in the country.</li> <li>• Tourists can see four of the Big Five: lions, elephants, rhinoceros and leopards.</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Best time for guided walking safaris and open vehicle game drives.</li> <li>• Very popular in the winter when most of the animals can be seen at the water holes.</li> <li>• Can stay in thatched cottages.</li> </ul>	

<p><b>3. Tanzania:</b> Mount Kilimanjaro (WHS)</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• It is the highest mountain in Africa.</li> <li>• It is at 5 895m, the world's tallest freestanding peak.</li> <li>• It is a dormant (inactive) volcano.</li> <li>• It is home to several endangered and protected plant- and animal species.</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Adventure activities include a five- day hike with overnight camping.</li> <li>• Other activities include: guided mountain tours, game viewing, and farming safaris.</li> <li>• This volcanic mountain forms part of the Kilimanjaro National Park.</li> </ul>	
<p>Serengeti National Park</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• The oldest park in Tanzania.</li> <li>• One of the best wild life sanctuaries in the world.</li> <li>• Many tourists visit the park during May or June.</li> <li>• It is one of the seven wonders of nature.</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• The park is best known for its annual migration of wildebeest, gazelle and zebra.</li> <li>• Mobile tented camps move with the wildlife as they migrate offering tourists on safari spectacular views.</li> <li>• Hot air balloon safaris, walking safaris, game drives, bush dinners and picnic spots.</li> </ul>	
<p><b>4. Zambia and Zimbabwe</b> Zambezi River</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• The <b>Zambezi river</b> is Africa's fourth largest river system.</li> <li>• This is also the source of the Victoria Falls.</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• White water rafting, and game viewing.</li> <li>• The river is also used for traditional ceremonies.</li> </ul>	
<p>Lake Kariba</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Africa's largest artificial dam.</li> <li>• Lake Kariba provides water and is used to generate hydroelectricity.</li> <li>• The lake is shared with Zimbabwe.</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Fishing, bird viewing, camping, cruises and water sports such as sailing are popular activities.</li> <li>• Tourists can stay in houseboats on the lake.</li> <li>• Tourists that want to know more about endangered wild life species.</li> <li>• This is home to the largest herds of game in eSwatini.</li> </ul>	

	<p><b>5. Zambia and Zimbabwe:</b> Victoria Falls (WHS)</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• The falls are spectacular to view.</li> <li>• The world's great natural wonder.</li> <li>• It is also referred to as Mosi-oa-Tunya which means "the smoke that thunders".</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Walk over the edge bridge to view the falls on Knife Edge.</li> <li>• White water rafting, bird and game-watching, bungee jumping, jet boats, abseiling, gorge swinging, kayaking, canoeing and raft floating.</li> <li>• Helicopter flights over the waterfall.</li> </ul>	
	<p>The Great Zimbabwe Ruins (WHS)</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• The second greatest stone structures in Africa, after the pyramids in Egypt.</li> <li>• The oldest &amp; largest ruins in the southern area.</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• For tourists who are interested in culture and history.</li> <li>• The largest ancient building south of Sahara Desert.</li> </ul>	
	<p>Matopo Hills (WHS)</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Mass of granite rocks formed by river erosions.</li> <li>• Very important in folklore &amp; tradition.</li> <li>• There are many rock paintings in the area drawn by the San people.</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• The area exhibits many distinctive rock formations.</li> <li>• Matopo means "bald heads" because of the appearance of granite hills.</li> <li>• Abundant in plant and animal species.</li> <li>• Cultural and historical tourists.</li> <li>• Include walking safaris and game viewing.</li> </ul>
